- **active participation of young people** in the democratic life, supporting their involvement in building youth policies;
- **inclusion of young people with fewer opportunities** (marginalized, disabled, immigrants, etc.);
- **non formal education.**

The thematic areas of the project

At local and regional level, each partner is actively engaged in implementing policies as well as in experimenting pilot project aiming to increase the recognition of youth work and non-formal learning. ENSA-Y project intends to make synergic all these local and regional actions building a common European framework. Therefore, the ENSA-Y's work plan is made for being **complementary** to each local and regional activity.
