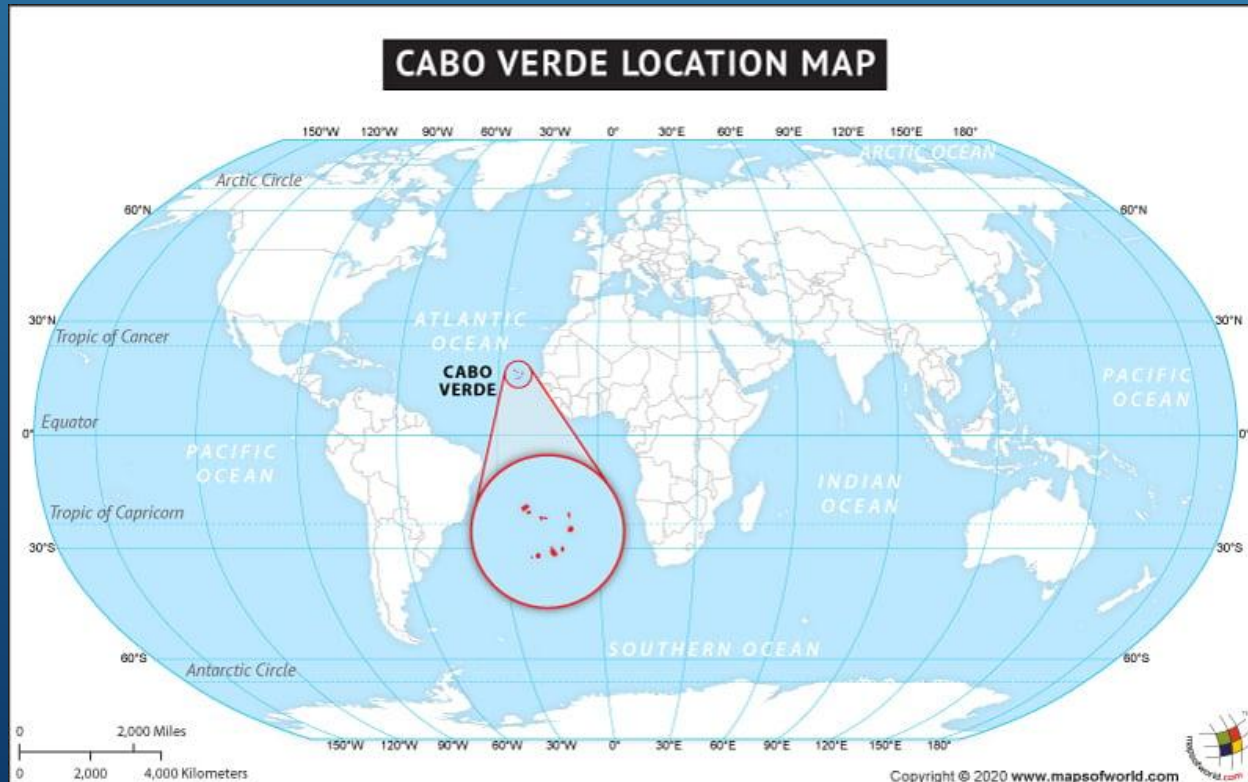

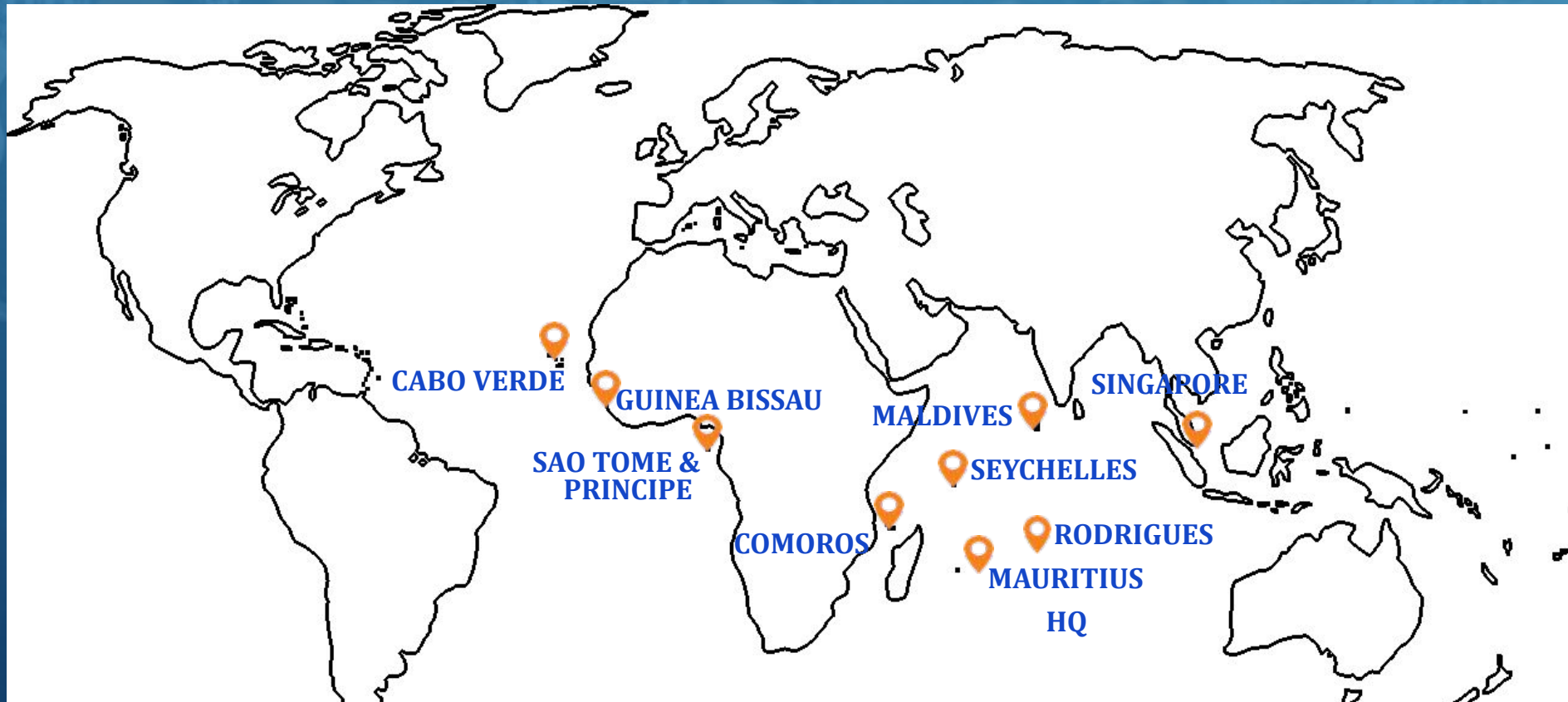

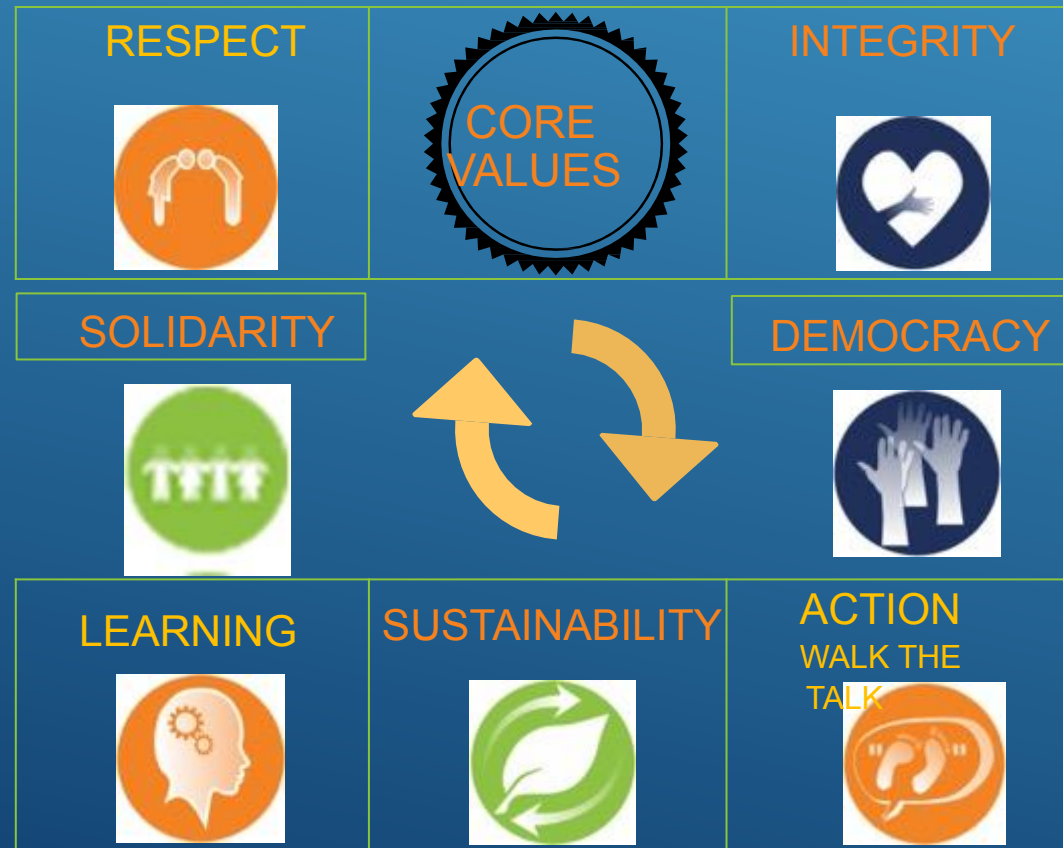

2016 ANO INTERNACIONAL DAS LEGUMINOSAS

1 Etimologia
Leguminosa
Do grego, e sua tradução é "pé", refere-se ao formato da planta, pois ela significa "pé que ergue, pé".

2 Leguminosas secas vs. Leguminosas vivas
Leguminosas secas
Referem-se a plantas cuja semente ou alimento obtido de uma semente.
Leguminosas vivas
São as sementes de plantas das famílias Leguminosae, referem-se apenas às sementes vivas.

3 Culturas de origem antiga
As leguminosas são parte essencial da dieta humana há milhares de anos.
A produção agrícola de feijão, do grão-de-bico e das lentilhas começou há 10000-8000 a.C.
Ingrediente versátil com alargado prazo de validade
As leguminosas podem ser armazenadas durante anos sem perder a sua alta valor nutritivo, proporcionando-se assim maior disponibilidade de alimentos entre as colheitas.
Ingredientes chave em muitos pratos tradicionais e regionais, são estes:
• Feijão verde • Zai
• Fava • Chão

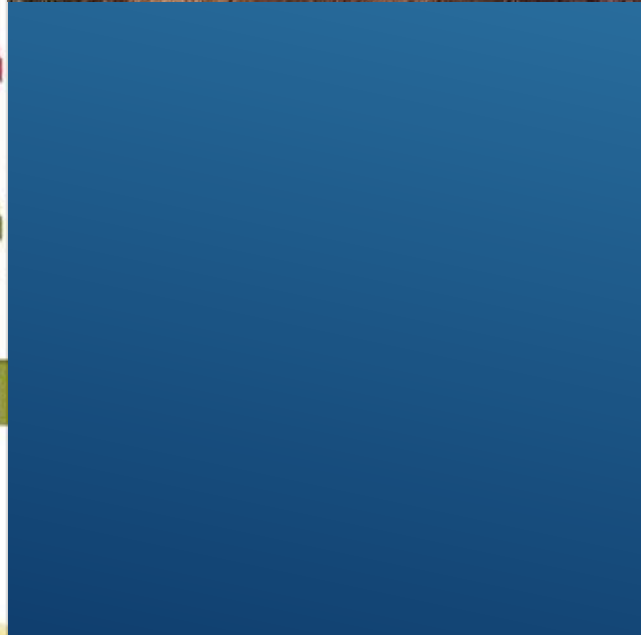
5 Parte da rede vital da biodiversidade
Fatores surpreendentes sobre as Leguminosas que têm um papel desatado
O sistema radicular de uma leguminosa cria um ambiente rico em biodiversidade agrícola, e este ambiente é essencial para as plantas e animais.
Uma floresta de abacajá, as leguminosas podem melhorar a fertilidade do solo, melhorar a qualidade do solo, melhorar a produtividade das terras agrícolas.

7 Uso eficiente da água
Consumo de água para produzir leguminosas em comparação com outros produtos de proteínas:
1 kg de lentilhas 1 kg de frango 1 kg de carneiro 1 kg de vaca
1 200 litros 4 925 litros 3 520 litros 11 000 litros
Um aliado inesperado contra as alterações climáticas
A ampla diversidade genética das leguminosas permite adaptar variedades tradicionais às condições de clima.
As plantas com origem de culturas vivas, as leguminosas melhoram naturalmente as condições de gases com efeito estufa.

9 Economicamente acessíveis e polivalentes
Essenciais e fáceis de produzir
Podem ser cultivadas em áreas marginais, com técnicas tradicionais.
Os resíduos de culturas de leguminosas podem ser utilizados como forragem natural.
Um superalimento poderoso
Rico em proteínas
Rico em fibra
Rico em vitaminas
Rico em minerais e flavonóides de saúde B
Rico em gordura
Rico em ácidos gordos
Rico em fibra
Rico em B12

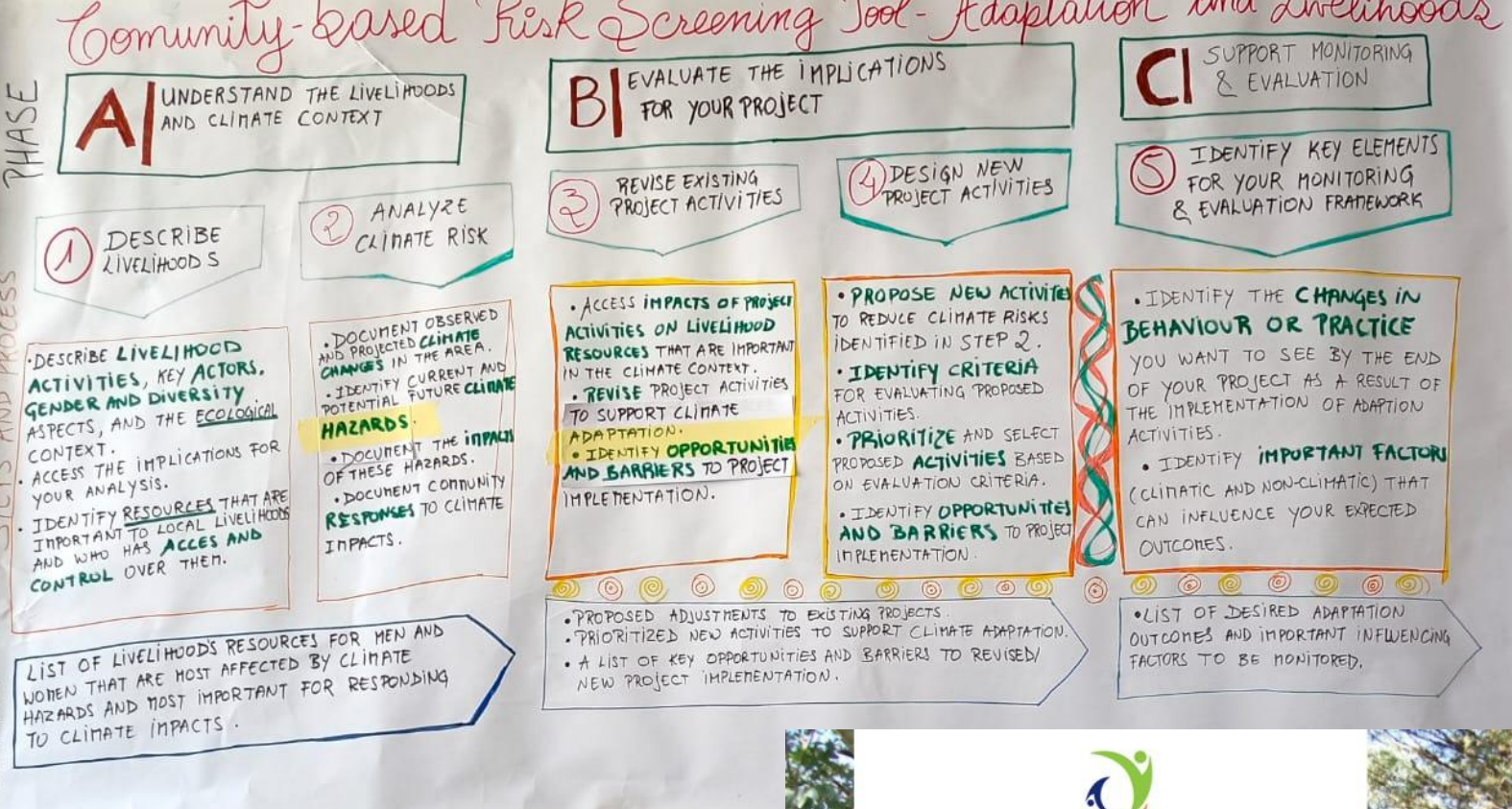
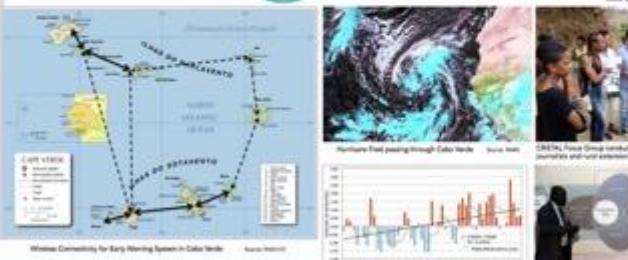


GOAL
 • Foster interaction with communities for knowledge sharing and prevention awareness

PRINCIPLES
 • Co-production of knowledge
 • Participatory approach and grassroots ownership
 • Direct observation and evidence based
 • Communities as key stakeholder for CIS
 • Consensus Forecasting for Risk Management
 • Dual way communication and exchange
 • Experiential acquisition of knowledge

OUTCOMES
 • Greater accuracy and ownership of prevention and risk reduction strategies achieved
 • Communities - Scientists dialogue promoted allowing integration of climate and local knowledge to address vulnerabilities and risk factors.
 • Innovative process facilitated to produce locally relevant Climate Information services and reinforce preparedness and risk management

WAY FORWARD
 • Implement a local Climate and DRR communication platform for Early Warning to stimulate co-production: combining local knowledge from communities and climate information services
 • Strengthen interaction amid stakeholders to support community preparedness and disaster management plans through direct relations
 • Continue enhancing the access and use of climate information for preparedness and DRR

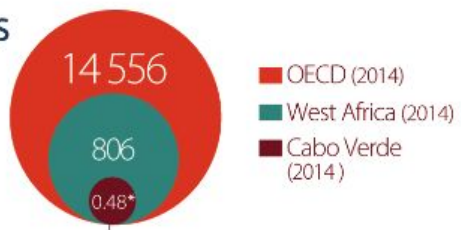

* Includes emissions from land use change and forestry

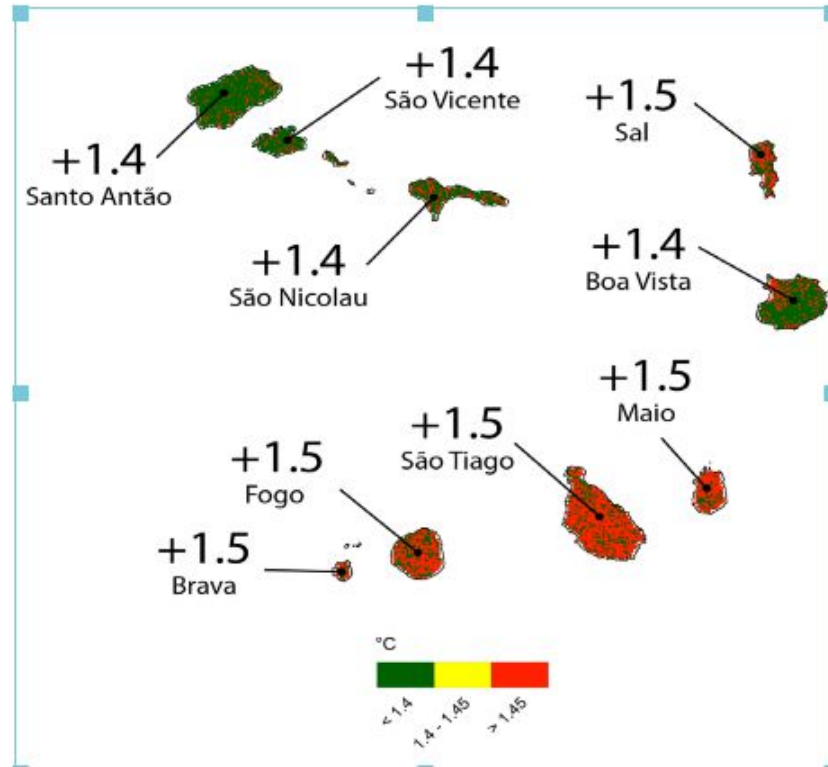
Sectoral emissions (2014)



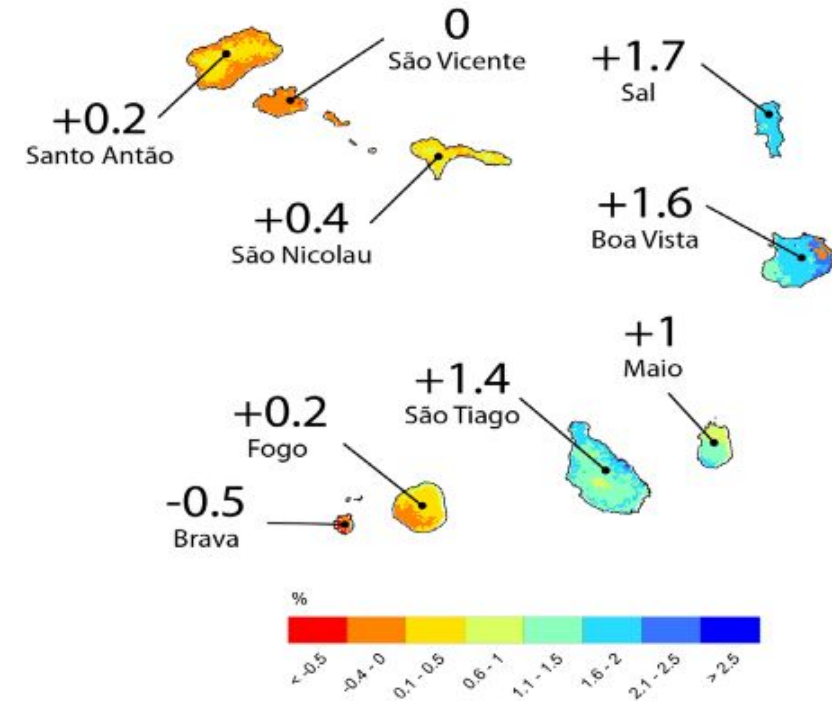

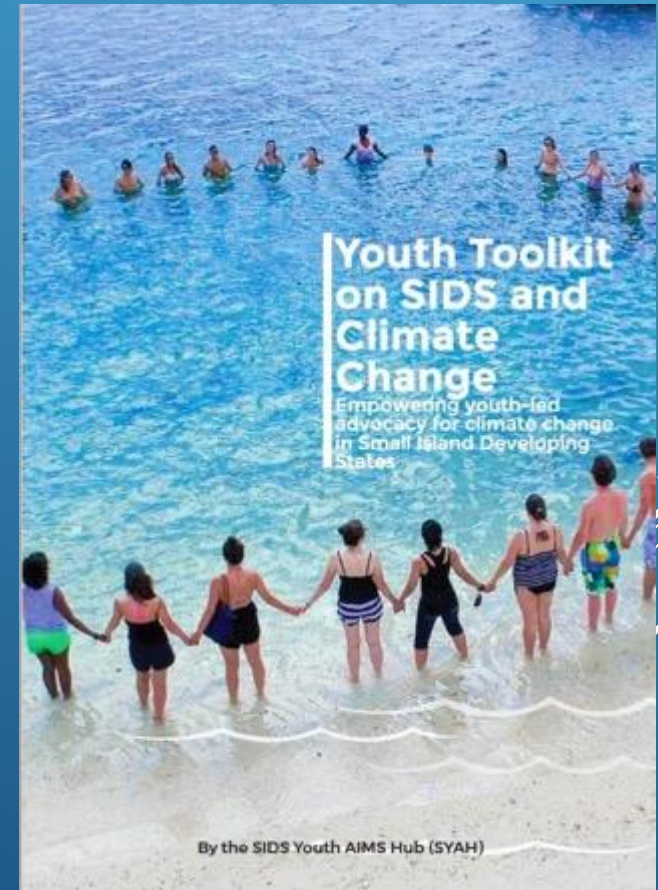

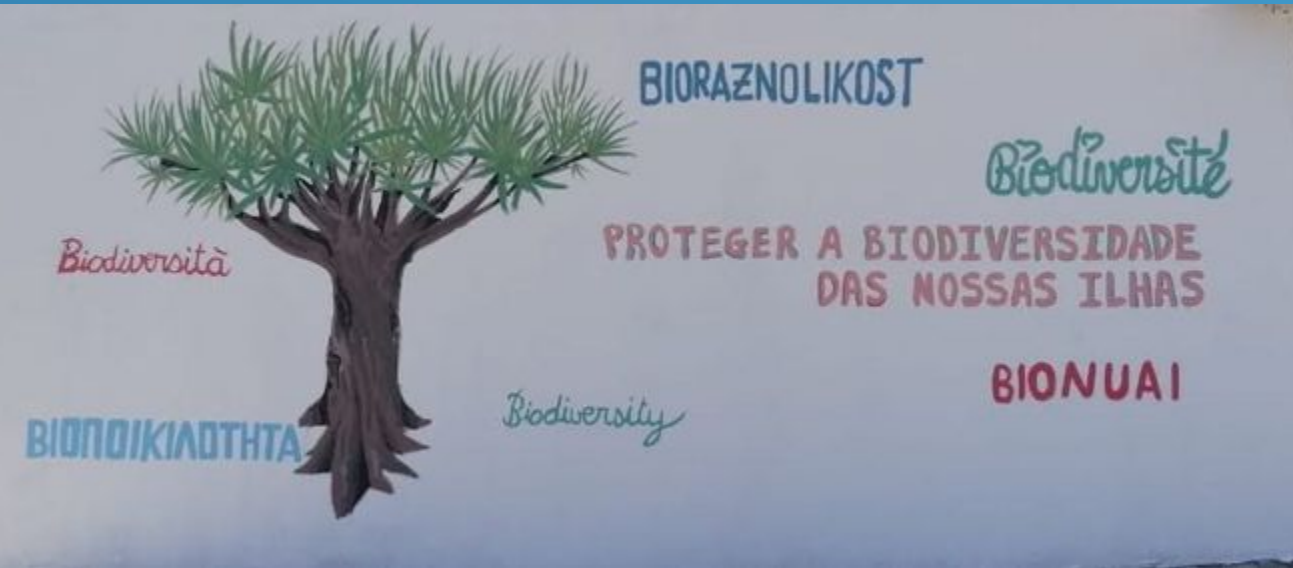
