Territorial framework

An organization serving the municipality of Belluno, the province, and the Veneto region.





Territorial challenges

Belluno, the provincial capital, serves as a point of reference for a very large and challenging mountainous area.

- Territorial fragmentation and dispersed settlement patterns.
- Complex management of public—private integration.
- Current shortage of highly specialized services.
- Long waiting times for diagnostic certifications.

Why is the project relevant?

It is estimated that there are **4,470 minors** with NPI (neuropsychiatric) disorders in the provincial territory, considering neuropsychiatric conditions as a whole.

Of these, **993 students** (in public schools) have disabilities — covered under Law No. 104/92 — and receive school support (with an increase of 200 cases in just 7 years).

Public, Social, and Economic Value

- Social: Improved quality of life, autonomy, and inclusion for children, adolescents, and young adults with disabilities;
- Economic: Creation of stable, skilled jobs and activation of local supply chains, with spillover benefits for social tourism, education, and events;
- Institutional: Stronger local welfare through collaboration among public institutions, schools, families, and universities; participatory governance and continuous professional development;
- Territorial: High-quality services that enable families to remain in small towns and valleys affected by depopulation;
- Attractiveness: An offering that enhances the city's appeal through the sustainable livability Belluno provides.
